

Information List of Scholarships Offered for Foreign Students in 2018 Academic Year

Application type

Individual application: The university only posts the offering circular. Prepare the necessary documents by yourself and directly make an application to the scholarship foundation.

Batch application: After preparing the necessary documents by yourself, submit them to the Student Welfare Section by the specified date. The university sends the documents of the applicants altogether to the foundation. (No selection is carried out by the university.)

Recommendation by university: In this type, the university receives a request for recommendation from the scholarship foundation in advance. We elect and recommend students considered to be eligible for the scholarship.

In principle, students with the residence status of “college student” are eligible for scholarships.
